Dear Families and Staff,

Tonight will be our 8th grade Graduation and it will start at 7:00 PM with the Mass, followed by a reception in the Parish Center.

Our last day of school is tomorrow, Thursday, May 19. We will have our awards for K-7 at 9:00 AM and parents are welcome, and then car riders will be dismissed at 11:05 AM, followed by the one bus at 11:15 AM. There will be NO Extended Care for anyone tomorrow.

Grade cards will go home tomorrow as well, unless there is money still owed to the school. Then you will get your report card after the payment is made. The school calendar for next year and the classroom supply lists will also be going home. You may also access both of these documents on the school website. Please note that we will not be in session on the Monday following the Parish Picnic. That day is Monday, August 22. Thanks for your attention on this matter.

We also want everyone to know that the Seamless Summer Option for free school lunches will expire at the end of June. This program has paid for all school lunches for our students since the fall of 2020. While all of us as parents greatly appreciate this program, sadly, it has come to an end.

Beginning in August of 2022, school lunch prices will go into effect once again for all students in grades K-12. Please be mindful of this increase in your household budget as the new school year approaches. It will be here before you know it.

Additionally, it is important to our school district for families that meet the requirements for the Free and Reduced Lunch Program to submit their applications. These applications will be sent home in early August. Not only is this program beneficial for families, but many federal and state programs also use school district free and reduced lunch rates as a qualifying factor for grant funding. Many times our school district misses out on these opportunities because of our low percentage of approved applications.

We will be starting our school year in the fall on Wednesday, August 17. We will have our Mandatory Parent Meeting on Tuesday, August 16 at 6:30 PM.
